MEMBERSHIPS AVAILABLE-----

Golf - includes unlimited golf and full membership privileges.

Clergy Golf - is golf membership, at a special rate.

Starter Golf – is golf membership, with two rate levels available: Level 1 - ages 25 to 29. Level 2 - ages 30 to 34.

Trial Golf -is an introductory golf membership. It is a one-time, one-year opportunity to try a golf membership out. If the trial member becomes a full member the next year, ½ the trial fee is applied to initiation.

Youth Incentive - for golfers ages 18 to 24. The annual flat fee can be reduced even further by recruiting up to 3 additional youth incentive membership applicants.

Junior Golf - provides elementary and secondary students with junior golf privileges. The junior golfer's parent(s) or guardian(s) have family social membership privileges.

Social - includes full use of the clubhouse facility and five (tee) times of golf at guest rates, during open play times.

MEMBERSHIP FEES-----

Initiation is a one-time fee paid by Golf, Clergy Golf, Starter Golf, Junior Golf and Social members. Payment options are available. This is a one-time fee – even if golf membership is not retained in consecutive years.

Annual Dues follow the calendar year. A two-part installment option is available.

Food & Beverage Minimum is an annual restaurant spending requirement, paid at the beginning of each year. Credit for food and beverage purchases is posted monthly, until the minimum is “used”. Rates are as follows:

***Family and Single Eligibility** - Family membership includes spouses, children under 18 (unless married or self-supporting), or unmarried children under age 24 who are full time students. To be eligible for single membership, the applicant must be unmarried, with no dependent children.

COURSE USE-----

Tee times and registration are required. Soft spikes are mandatory. Grandchild rates are available.

Saturdays, Sundays

& Holidays: 7 to 11 a.m. - members and their guests, only. Open play after 11 a.m.

Mondays: Open play all day – alternate Mondays the course is closed until noon for maintenance.

Tuesdays: Women members and their guests only.

Wednesdays: Men members and their guests only.

Thursdays & Fridays Open play until noon. Noon to sunset – members and their guests, only.

TO APPLY-----

Application Form –Complete the application form and submit it along with the application fee to the club office staff. The application will be submitted to the board of directors for approval. Following board approval, the application fee is deposited and the applicant is admitted to membership. The fee may be paid by cash, check, or credit card.

The Application Fee - The fee submitted with Golf, Social or Starter Membership applications will be applied to initiation. The fee submitted with trial and youth incentive memberships is the flat fee for membership.

Re-Entry Applications - Applicants who were members previously must submit an application to be approved by the board of directors. The re-entry fee, 20% of current dues, may be waived, at the discretion of the current board of directors.
